

Wireless Equipment and Network – Journeyman Radio Technician

- Experience with Kenwood, DMR, NXDN, P25 Phase I/II is highly desirable
- The ability to program, troubleshoot and perform system diagnostics on complex radio systems.
- Experience in diagnostics, repair, maintenance, program wireless communication equipment such as 2-way radios, transmitters, receivers, antennas for customers.
- Knowledge of battery backup systems, base stations, repeaters, multicouplers and duplexers, basic networking skills.
- Candidates must possess clean driving record and valid driver's license.
- FCC General Radiotelephone Operator License, FCIA, NABER or equivalent industry certification a plus.
- Valid Driver's License.
- Clean driving record is required.
